

Marriage License Filing Requirements in Nodaway County, Missouri

The 1st Party and 2nd Party must

- Visit our office TOGETHER* to apply for a marriage license.
- Be 18 years of age or over**.
- Present a valid government issued ID and provide Social Security number.
- **Pay \$51.00 CASH or debit/credit card (no checks).**
- Provide name and phone number of the person performing the ceremony.
- Have a ceremony performed within 30 days from the date of issuance in the State of Missouri.
- If previously married, must provide date when last marriage ended.
- **NOT** be related to each other down through and including first cousins.

*If either party is unable to appear in the Recorder's Office to apply, due to Military Service, ADA Qualifying Disability or Incarceration, an Affidavit of Absent Applicant may be provided.

**If the 1st Party and/or 2nd Party are between the ages of 15-18, custodial parent must accompany applicants to give consent to the application. A judge's order is required if under the age of 15.

Return and Record of Marriage

- The person performing the ceremony is required by law to return the completed license to the Nodaway County Recorder of Deed's office within 15 days of the ceremony. An envelope is provided to mail license back to the office.

Copies

- Copies are available as soon as the marriage license has been returned and recorded.
 - Plain copy \$1.00
 - Certified statement \$2.00
 - Certified copy \$10.00
