

Nodaway County's Policy for Distribution of CARES Act Funds

On May 12, 2020, the Nodaway County Commission adopted this policy for Distribution of the CARES Act funds. This policy may be revised at any time due to new or changing information.

Phase I

Turn in Receipts for Reimbursement from March 1, 2020 to June 30, 2020 to be paid out by July 15

Any bills under \$10,000 would be paid at 100%. All others would be paid at 75% then in the final phase if there is money available in the fund the remainder would be paid at a population-based percentage. The total funds being disbursed during this phase will not exceed \$750,000.00

Phase II

Turn in receipts for Reimbursement from July 1, 2020 to September 30, 2020 to be paid by October 15.

Any bills under \$10,000 would be paid at 100%. All others would be paid at 75% then in the final phase if there is money available in the fund the remainder would be paid at a population-based percentage. The total funds being disbursed during this phase will not exceed \$550,000.

Phase III

Turn in receipts for Reimbursement from October 1, 2020 to December 30, 2020 to be paid by January 15, 2021.

Any bills under \$10,000 would be paid at 100%. All others would be paid at 75% then in the final phase if there is money available in the fund the remainder would be paid at a population-based percentage. The total funds being disbursed during this phase will not exceed \$550,000.

FINAL Phase

Any bills not presented in the first three phases must be presented by February 15, 2021 and the March 1, 2021 payout would be based on the amount of funds remaining with a population-based percentage.
