What Do I Do If I Receive a Bad Check?

If you receive a bad check, it is **passed in Nodaway County** and meets all requirements for prosecuting a bad check, you will need to:

- 1. Send a statutory notice using the form for insufficient funds checks or stop payment checks.
- 2. Follow the procedures in the bad check packet.
- 3. Wait ten (10) days after the writer of the check receives the written notice.
- 4. If the check remains unpaid, you will bring the following to the Nodaway County Prosecutor's Office:
 - the original bad check
 - the original document showing written notice was received by the check writer
 - a completed bad check submission form
 - a completed probable cause affidavit for insufficient funds checks or probable cause affidavit for stop payment checks.
